PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2018

Good Afternoon. Welcome to the 2018 Annual General Meeting of the PIB/NGIB/HQ/PIR Association.

BACKGROUND ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES 2017/2018

The years 2017 and 2018 have been particularly busy ones for ALL Committee members and their families, both throughout Queensland and interstate. I wish to thank them all sincerely. On Tuesday, 8 August 2017 we commemorated the 75th Anniversary of the Kokoda Campaign. Much effort in the planning, liaison and execution by all ensured that the Kokoda Day Commemoration Service conducted at the Rotary Kokoda Memorial Wall, Cascade Gardens, Broadbeach, QLD., supported by our Association was an outstanding success.

This Kokoda Day Commemoration Service celebrated the 75th Anniversary of the defence of Kokoda, PNG, 8-10 August, 1942 by the 39th Australian Infantry Battalion and the Papuan Infantry Battalion. It was significant that representatives from the 2/14th, 39th and 2/16th Battalions attended this Memorial Service with us.

Our Patron, Major General "Hori" Howard, AO, MC, ESM, delivered a most positive, honest and detailed address on this vital campaign to all who were fortunate enough to attend this historic Commemoration. As your President, I addressed the audience on the significant background planning and execution of the Kokoda Memorial Wall, which was undertaken by the sculptor David Yardley.

In recognition of his outstanding efforts in producing the Kokoda Memorial Wall in such great detail, I presented him with a framed Life Membership Certificate on behalf of our Association. Two new pavers were installed for two former AIF NCO's who served in PNG. The Commemoration Service was followed by a most enjoyable luncheon at the Surfer's Paradise RSL, during which our Secretary, Kev Horton, excelled as MC.

INTERSTATE REPRESENTATION 26th and 28th August, 2017 – MELBOURNE AND CANBERRA

On the 26th August, 2017 at the invitation of the Presidents of the 39th, 2/14th and 2/16th Battalions I, as your President, together with your Vice-President, Greg Ivey, represented our Association at a most impressive Kokoda Memorial Service. This was conducted at the Shrine of Remembrance, Melbourne, which was attended by the State Governor of Victoria, our former Patron, Major General the Honourable Michael Jeffery, AC, CVO, MC, Chief of Army LT General Angus Campbell CSC, (whose father was a Major who served with PIR in the 60's!) together with many other local dignitaries. Several of our interstate Members were also present at the Service, including veteran Sqt Don Collins of 2 NGIB.

On behalf of our Association I laid a beautiful fresh flower wreath in our Regimental colours of red and green at the Cenotaph. Our Association attendance was much appreciated by all local participants. This solemn Memorial Service was followed by the Official Lunch at the RACV Club, Bourke Street, which was addressed by Major General Jeffery on the significance and history of the Kokoda Campaign.

Greg Ivey arranged a most relaxed and enjoyable luncheon for our Association members at the famous "Chloe's" Restaurant in the historic Young and Jackson's Hotel in Flinders Street.

CANBERRA 28th August 2017

On behalf of our Association, Vice President, Greg Ivey attended a Memorial Service at the Australian War Memorial, Canberra, in honour of Lt. A. A. Smith (PIB), A Wreath was laid for our Association.

It is hoped that they and other PNG Nationals will attend our future wreath laying ceremonies at the PNG Memorial.
